**2016/17 Summary**

Our Sport Premium initiatives for 2016/17 have included supporting individual children to achieve their full potential and improve readiness to learn by developing healthy bodies and minds through:

- Wake up, shake up' activities before school
- Timetabled sessions in the purpose built ball court
- Timetabled additional swimming sessions for individual children to promote healthy lifestyles
- Providing opportunities to participate in Friday afternoon sports clubs
- Providing sports coaches to ensure active sessions before school, at lunchtimes and playtimes
- Providing targeted physical activity sessions
- Utilising sports coach expertise to ensure that we develop our PE curriculum, increasing opportunities for pupils to participate in sport and develop their knowledge and understanding of what makes a healthy lifestyle

**2017/18 Summary**

Our Sport Premium initiatives for 2017/18 will have a primary focus on **developing children’s self- esteem and resilience through sport and engaging children in a lifetime love of sport and physical activity.**

**To do this we will:**

- Provide opportunities for children to participate in sports activities to develop their self-esteem and resilience
- Use the results of the 2016/17 eHNA as a baseline to ensure impact can be monitored and evaluated
- Employ a qualified swimming teacher/sports coach to provide additional activities to engage children in a lifetime love of sport
- Promote the teaching of healthy lifestyles and lifestyle choices
- Develop outcomes for children through employing a positive role model
- Work with teaching staff to develop PE schemes of work to promote a love of sport and physical activity
