



Warley Road Primary School

PE and Sport Premium Funding 2017/18

This statement is to provide information about the use of the premium up to and including March 2018. It includes a full breakdown of how it has been spent (or will be spent); what impact the school has seen on pupils' PE and sport participation and attainment and how the improvements will be sustainable in the future. Schools should also consider how their use of the premium is giving pupils the opportunity to develop a healthy, active lifestyle.

Purpose of the Grant

The premium must be used to fund additional and sustainable improvements to the provision of PE and sport, and to encourage the development of healthy, active lifestyles.

Allocations are calculated using the number of pupils in Year 1 to 6 and those age 5 in Year R as follows:

- Schools with 17 or more eligible pupils receive £16,000 plus £10 per eligible pupil
- Schools with 16 or fewer eligible pupils receive £1000 per eligible pupil

Aims

As a school we will aspire to offer the following provision

- To improve the physical education experience for all children in our school
- To increase opportunities for physical activity for all children
- To enable our children to enjoy a range of sport outside of the school curriculum
- To ensure the development of school sport is linked to wider agendas

Funding Allocation

In 2016/17 this money was used to employ specialist sports coaches to provide additional opportunities beyond the school day.

- Work alongside teachers and lunchtime supervisors/play leaders to increase their subject knowledge, skill and confidence in the teaching of PE and active lifestyles
- Offer our children the opportunity to participate in sports outside of the normal curriculum
- Use their expertise to ensure that we develop our PE curriculum, increasing opportunities for pupils to participate in sport and develop their knowledge and understanding of what makes a healthy lifestyle

This year, 2017/18, alongside the sports coaches, we are looking to employ a swimming and sports coach to:

- Further improve the profile of PE and develop a greater understanding of what leading a healthy lifestyles means
- Offer our children the opportunity to participate in sports outside of the normal curriculum eg.fencing
- Continue to provide opportunities for children to represent Warley Road in sport festivals and competitions

- Support the whole school development of PE through training and modelling of best practice eg. increasing lunchtime staff skills, development of teaching staff expertise
- Provide additional opportunities to engage children in a lifetime love of sport and fitness.

Impact

- Lunchtime staff successfully engaging with the children and encouraging children to engage in more active activities
- Reduction in number of lunchtime incidents as the children are active and engaged
- Increased opportunity for children to engage in before and after school sports clubs
- Increased range of sporting opportunities on offer
- Increased understanding of the importance of leading a healthy lifestyle

Sustainability

- Third party sports coaches to continue to model good practice to ensure sustainability in the short / medium term
- Employed swimming and sports coach to work towards creating a legacy of quality first teaching of sports at Warley Road.
